2008 Méthode Champenoise

\$32.00

Silver medal – Adelaide Hills Wine Show 2009

Our Méthode Champenoise is a blend of Pinot Noir and Chardonnay grapes selected from the cool south-facing slopes high in the Adelaide Hills. Each bottle is hand-crafted, with tirage, riddling and disgorging being carried out on side in our Longwood winery. Ageing from a minimum of 12 months on lees adds hints of toasted nuts to the sweet strawberry and crisp green apple fruit aromas.

2009 Sauvignon Blanc

Small lot ferments using a variety of yeast strains has added many layers to this wine. Elegant stone fruit and pear aromas meld with herbaceous hints, which follow through to the palate. Soft acid structure is balanced by sweet fruit.

2009 Pinot Gris

We picked the Gris in two passes at differing ripeness to produce a wine with fine structure and lifted fruit aromas. Partial barrel ferment with moderate lees stirring has given extra depth on the palate. This wine will be tight and crisp while young, and develop extra body and nectar characters with bottle age.

2008 Pinot Noir

Plum and cherry aromas abound, which follow through to the palate. Fine tannins at the finish give the wine length and structure. This wine can be drunk now to enjoy these lifted fruit characters, or left to age 5 – 8 years to see development of more savoury, earthy flavours.

2008 Reserve Chardonnay - Lenswood

Our reserve Chardonnay was fermented in 15% new and the rest 2-4 year old French oak, with weekly lees stirring for the 2 months following ferment. Ageing for 15 months prior to bottling has produced a rich yet tightly balanced Chardonnay. Sweet honey and nectar aromas are complemented with toasted nut characters from the oak.

2008 Reserve Shiraz (Maximum 3 bottles per order)

This wine was aged in a mix of new and old French oak. The dry conditions of 07 were favourable for ripening Shiraz in the hills, giving excellent depth and length of flavour, yet retaining signature pepper and spice characters on the nose. Fine tannins add structure and give savoury elements on the palate. This wine can be drunk now, or will gain complexity from cellaring.
